

SAP Rules at Rocky Mount Rules

1. Respect each other and the staff at Rocky Mount.

We show respect for ourselves and others by:

- a.) We do not use bad language.
- b.) If something does not belong to us, we do not touch it without permission.
- c.) **We do not tease others.** We do not hit, push, make threats or act in a threatening way toward others

- c. walk instead of run
